

If you're planning a trip to Tanzania, it's important to know the travel requirements before you go. Here's a comprehensive guide to help you prepare for your journey:

#### Vaccination

You do not need to show a COVID vaccination certificate or negative COVID test to enter Tanzania.

Health officials may screen you for COVID symptoms on arrival.

#### Visa requirements:

#### 1. Passport validity

If you are visiting Tanzania, your passport should be valid for 6 months from the date you arrive.

If you are a resident in Tanzania, your passport must be valid for 6 months from the date you arrive.

#### 2. Visas

Tanzania has introduced an 'e-visas' system through which applications can be submitted and approved online in advance of travel.

#### 3. Flight information

To be shared 1 week before the program begins.

#### **Accommodation**

The Volunteer Homes are located in the village of Kizimkazi, Zanzibar, Tanzania. Kizimkazi is a fishing village situated on the southern coast of Unguja, the main island of Zanzibar. The village is approximately 75 minutes away from the Zanzibar International Airport and from Stone Town, the historic centre of Zanzibar City. It is comfortable and decent, but quite basic. There are common areas and a kitchen for your use. We recommend that you bring your own cotton bed sheets, as it can be more comfortable. Additionally, regarding laundry, we provide a small support payment of \$8 to our lady cleaner, who also prepares breakfast for the house.

#### **Dress Code**

At the school, it is important to dress modestly and respectfully, as Zanzibar is a predominantly muslim region.

Here are some guidelines for appropriate attire:

- Both men and women should wear clothing that covers their shoulders and knees. T-shirts, long sleeve tops, and knee-length skirts or trousers are ideal.
- Women should avoid tight-fitting or revealing clothing. Loose-fitting pants, skirts, and dresses are preferable.
- It is not required for women to wear a headscarf at the school, but you may choose to do so if you feel more comfortable.
- Comfortable, closed-toe shoes are recommended as you may be on your feet for extended periods.

Overall, it's essential to be mindful of the local culture and customs, and dress accordingly to maintain a respectful and professional atmosphere at the school.

#### Code of Conduct

You must abide by the rules and listen to your supervisor's instructions the entire duration of the trip. Please note that in the case of any serious misbehaviour, Learning Lab has the right to send a student back home.

#### **Payment:**

The total cost is AED 8500 + VAT for 6 nights/7 days.

Non-refundable deposit of AED 2550 + VAT to be paid at the time of registration via a payment link.

The remaining balance must be paid in full 2 weeks before the program begins.

Once payment has been completed, you will receive an email with a receipt.

#### **Cancellation Charges / Refund**

In the event of any cancellation, the student must provide a written notice 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the program. The refund will be processed within 4 to 6 weeks.
