Immersive Learning

The bootcamp combines Al learning, teamwork, and leadership modules, tailored to high-school students.

Portfolio-Ready Projects

Each team completes a real-world Al solution - strengthening academic and professional pathways.

Stanford Mentor-Led Sessions

Guided by Stanford mentors, students learn hands-on Al applications, project design, and pitching skills.



OUR APPROACH

Experiential Learning Journey: Students learn by doing - building Al solutions, solving real-world challenges, and applying knowledge through hands-on sprints rather than memorizing theory.

Collaboration At The Core: Teams bring together diverse perspectives to design impactful projects. Every idea matters, and every student plays a critical role in shaping the outcome.

Critical Thinking Meets Technology: From data ethics to system design, students are encouraged to think deeply, question assumptions, and connect technology to human needs.






Supportive and relatable, they guide participants through challenges, share real-world insights, and foster an environment of collaboration and growth. With genuine enthusiasm for mentoring, they adapt to students' evolving needs, encourage curiosity, and build relationships that often extend beyond the program through ongoing mentorship and guidance.

MODULE 1:

KICKOFF & FOUNDATIONS

- Challenge framing: themes, scope, and success metrics
- Mentor talks on problem selection, datasets, and UX
- Problem statement workshop
- Tech setup, workflow introduction, and environment build
- UX sprint: user flows, wireframes, and data needs
- Data planning and first draft of Model Card





MODULE 2: BUILDING THE CORE

- Introduction to API design and back-end structure
- Back-end development: database, routes, and APIs
- Data preparation and training of a baseline model
- Connecting model outputs with the back-end
- Testing, integration, and validation of early prototypes

MODULE 3:BRINGING IDEAS TO LIFE

- Introduction to front-end design and user experience
- Front-end sprint: Layouts, components, and API connection
- Model refinement: Tweaks, evaluation, and improvements
- End-to-end testing and polishing the user journey
- Pitch workshop: Narrative building, slides, and demo preparation





MODULE 4: CLOSING CEREMONY AND PITCH DAY

- Final project refinements and polish
- Team presentations and demo fair
- Judge walkthroughs and mentor reflections
- Awards ceremony and feedback session
- Networking and closing celebration

Engage Creatively: Students aren't just listening - they're building, experimenting, and bringing ideas to life through innovation sprints.

Solve Real Problems: Projects are inspired by global issues in healthcare, law, governance, and ethics, ensuring relevance beyond theory.


Boost Design Thinking: Students learn to frame problems, design user journeys, and integrate Al with creativity and critical thinking.

Collaborate and Lead: Teams work like real-world startups, sharing roles, brainstorming solutions, and pitching ideas.
