





The Challenge: Low-income students don't know about available scholarships and resources

The Solution: Al-powered resource matching system paired with peer mentor network to guide students through applications

Leadership Applied: Visionary leadership, strategic partnerships, agile implementation plan

Outcome: Partnership with guidance department, 50 students enrolled in pilot
